With so much attention to the opioid epidemic on youth and families, little attention is given to the older adults.

- The negative impact of stigma, stereotyping, and shame
- The positive impact of support, education, treatment, and recovery.

2. Participants will be able to identify personal and societal biases toward individuals who are aging and might have a major problem (often hidden) with alcohol and/or drugs.
